## Off-Campus Lunch Permission Form

Members of the Senior Class will be permitted to leave campus in automobiles for lunch during the designated lunch periods during the school year provided that:

1. An off-campus permission form signed by student and parents is on file in the school office.
2. The student meets all academic and attendance eligibility standards including, but not limited to, those provided in the Student Handbook which define eligibility for extra-curricular activity participation and academic probation.

The privilege will be suspended for any of the following reasons:

1. If the student incurs two tardies, the privilege will be suspended for the rest of the semester.
2. Returning to campus at excessive speed or disorderly or unsafe fashion (as determined by a staff/faculty member) will, upon the first occurrence, result in total suspension of the privilege for the remainder of the school year.
3. Any signs of irresponsibility while off campus will result in suspension of the privilege for the remainder of the school year.

Seniors who do not have cars and meet all above requirements may ride with those students designated by their parents/guardians on this off-campus permission form.
